

2027 Tuition Fee Schedule – International Students

This 2027 Tuition Fee Schedule is effective from 1 January 2027 and supersedes all previously issued Tuition Fee Schedules.

- Tuition fees detailed in your Offer Letter are indicative only.
- Tuition fees are reviewed annually and may increase from year to year.
- The actual cost of study for any term cannot be determined until you have enrolled.
- Once enrolled, you will be able to access your student account through MyCQU and view your Fee Notice.
- The Fee Notice will detail:
 - the tuition fee charged for each unit enrolment; and
 - any payments, discounts or other credits applied to your account.

NOTE: Account details and Fee Notices are not available until fees have been calculated.

Tuition fees are generally calculated:

- o December – Research Higher Degree candidates;
- o January – Be Different, ELICOS and Graduate Certificate Research students; and
- o February – all other students.

Following these initial calculations, fees will be calculated as enrolments are processed throughout the year.

Tuition fees for each unit of study are calculated on a per-credit-point basis. Unless otherwise specified, examples shown in this Schedule that refer to a "Fee per Unit" assume a standard unit value of six (6) credit points. Individual units may have a credit point value that differs from the standard value. Students should refer to the [CQUni Handbook](#) for information regarding the credit point value of individual units.

Students should refer to the [2027 Academic Calendar of Principal Dates](#) in the CQUni Handbook each term for information regarding the last date to withdraw from a unit without incurring financial liability.

NOTE: **Census** dates for withdrawal without financial liability apply to all students (domestic and international), except students enrolled in Research Higher Degrees.

Research study is time-based rather than credit-point based. Students consume EFTSL in funded places and, where not enrolled in a funded place, tuition fees are charged for each day of enrolment. Withdrawal from a unit or course prior to a census date does not remove any financial liability incurred prior to withdrawal or re-credit any funded EFTSL already consumed.

Students enrolled in courses with monthly intakes (for example, CL58 Graduate Certificate Research) or studying through the Be Different platform may have census dates that differ from the standard Term 1, Term 2 and Term 3 census dates.
