

International Research Scholarship

The International Research Scholarship is available to new international students who meet the academic and English entry requirements for a Higher Degree by Research course at CQUniversity Australia.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All International Research Scholarship recipients are governed by these terms and conditions.

1. The International Research Scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to international students, undertaking one of the following courses at CQUniversity:
 - a. CQ16 Doctor of Education
 - b. CL81 Doctor of Philosophy
 - c. CM33 Doctor of Philosophy (Industry)
 - d. CL80 Master of Research
 - e. CD84 Doctor of Philosophy by Portfolio
 - f. CD85 Master of Research (Offshore)
 - g. CD86 Doctor of Philosophy Offshore
 - h. CL58 Graduate Certificate in Research packaged with one of the above courses.
2. The International Research Scholarship is not available for ELICOS or other any other course within a packaged offer.
3. The International Research Scholarship is available to new international students commencing study at CQUniversity, and to current CQUniversity students who have completed a postgraduate coursework qualification and are applying to commence a Higher Degree by Research course at CQUniversity.
4. The International Research Scholarship is not available in conjunction with any other CQUniversity scholarship.
5. The International Research Scholarship is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
6. The International Research Scholarship is calculated and applied on a per unit basis.
7. The International Research Scholarship remains valid whilst the student:
 - a. remains enrolled in compulsory terms at CQUniversity;
 - b. pays all tuition and additional fees/costs in accordance with CQUniversity policy, ensuring tuition fees are paid in full by census date each term;
 - c. meets the conditions of their student visa (if recipient is on a student visa).
8. The International Research Scholarship will discontinue if the student named on the Letter of Offer:
 - a. has overdue tuition fees and/or outstanding debts after census date of each term;
 - b. is identified as being at Level 3 of Academic Progression on their enrolment;
 - c. graduates from their nominated course; or cancels their enrolment; or has their enrolment cancelled at CQUniversity.
9. As per the refund policy, refund amounts payable to students may be adjusted to include the recouping of waived published fees such as the repayment of any International Research Scholarship in accordance with the terms and conditions of those scholarships.
10. A student who withdraws from their course before completion, as outlined in their Letter of Offer and Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE), or who transfers to another education provider, will be required to repay the value of the International Research Scholarship applied to all completed study terms. CQUniversity reserves the right to recover any outstanding amount by deducting it from a refund payable to the student and/or issuing an invoice for payment of the outstanding balance.
11. The International Research Scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days' written notice, should the student breach any of these terms and conditions.

APPEALS

There is no right of appeal should the applicant be unsuccessful in securing a scholarship or has their scholarship withdrawn.

The terms and conditions may be changed at any time and the University will provide 20 working days' written notice to all current International Research Scholarship recipients. Students who are uncertain about any of the terms and conditions, are encouraged to speak to the Student Services team at their campus.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

This is a merit-based scholarship based on applicant's academic achievement in their prior studies.

All applications will be assessed by CQUniversity's International Admission team and the applicant will be notified accordingly within the Letter of Offer.

If eligible, the scholarship offered will provide a 25% reduction of applicant's tuition fees for the duration of the course.
